- Assist summer camp activity-based curriculum to promote social, emotional, physical, and cognitive development;
- Make materials and activities based around weekly camp themes;
- Assist with daily tasks, such as meals, car line, nap-time, transitions and clean-up;
- Assist children with all physical needs to be safe and clean in a respectful manner;
- Assist all children who need guidance and direction in hallways, playgrounds, and changing of programs.

Qualifications

- Must have a minimum of 2 years of experience working with children with children aged 1 - 12 years;
- Experience working with children in a Montessori school environment is a plus.
- Prior camp experience preferred, but not required;
- Must be highly motivated, hard-working, and flexible, demonstrate a desire to learn, show initiative, and have a sense of humor;
- Must have knowledge of minimum standards, health and safety practices, social and emotional development, and classroom management;

- Must pass all required clearances (PA Child Abuse, Pennsylvania Access to Criminal History, Federal Criminal History Background Check);
- Must be able to sit comfortably on the floor with children and bend, squat, and kneel with ease;
- Ability to navigate stairs;
- Must be able to lift up to 35 pounds.
