- Support the lead teacher in planning and implementing a Montessori curriculum in math, literacy, cultural studies, and science.

- Observe and document student progress to inform instruction and communicate with families as needed.

- Michigan Elementary Teacher Certification is preferred but not required.
- Strong classroom management skills grounded in respect, consistency, and care.
- Ability to work collaboratively in a team-based teaching model and to take initiative when needed.
- An understanding of and commitment to inclusive teaching practices and DEIB work.
- Excellent communication, organizational, and interpersonal skills.
- A growth mindset and willingness to reflect, learn, and grow alongside colleagues and students.
